<p>7. Plans for a Defibrillator in the Village</p> <p>A quote will be obtained to give an idea of cost for a defibrillator that could be used on adults or children. The model suggested is used by Notts Police. Storage with an electrical supply will be needed. Siting was discussed and ambulance response times.</p> <p>Mr Brooks will speak to Fire Service HQ to see if the proposed defibrillator could be located at the front of the Fire Station. Checking of the equipment could then be included in the Fire Station's weekly checks.</p> <p>Mrs Herbert will chase details of the Community Responders Scheme, who are part of East Midlands Ambulance Service (EMAS) and dispatch first responders.</p> <p>Mr Sheldon is hosting a fundraising BBQ in July for the Rotary Club who has agreed to donate funds for a defibrillator. Mr Hindmarsh said that Village Care will also donate.
